Significant (adjective) اہمیت سے بھرپور، قابلِ توجہ، قابلِ ملاحظہ

sufficiently great or important to be worthy of attention; noteworthy.

Example: "a significant increase in sales"

Synonyms: notable, noteworthy, worthy of attention, remarkable, outstanding, important, of importance

Antonyms: insignificant, minor

Forsake (verb) چھوڑنا، ترک کرنا، چھوڑ دینا، چھوڑ کر چلنا، چھوڑ کر جانا

abandon or leave.

Example: "he would never forsake Tara"

Synonyms: abandon, desert, leave, quit, depart from, leave behind, leave high and dry, turn one's back on

Antonyms: stay with, return to

Jaded (adjective) اکتاہٹ سے بھرپور ہونے کی وجہ سے دلچسپی سے محروم ہونا

bored or lacking enthusiasm, typically after having had too much of something.

Example: "meals to tempt the most jaded appetites"

Synonyms: satiated, sated, surfeited, glutted, cloyed, gorged, dulled, blunted, deadened

Antonyms: fresh

Atrocity (noun) انتہائی برائی یا ظلمت کا عمل

an extremely wicked or cruel act, typically one involving physical violence or injury.

Example: "a textbook which detailed war atrocities"

Synonyms: cruelty, abomination, enormity, outrage, horror, monstrosity, obscenity, iniquity, violation

Antonyms: agreeableness, delightfulness, pleasantness

Chaos (noun) مکمل طور پر بے ترتیبی اور الجھن

complete disorder and confusion.

Example: "snow caused chaos in the region"

Synonyms: disorder, disarray, disorganization, confusion, mayhem, bedlam, pandemonium, madness

Antonyms: order, orderliness

Perpetuate (verb) کچھ کو مستقل طور پر قائم رکھنا

make (something) continue indefinitely.

Example: "the confusion was perpetuated through inadvertence"

Synonyms: keep alive, keep going, keep in existence, preserve, conserve, sustain, maintain

Antonyms: abolish, abrogate, annul, blot out

Reminiscent (adjective) قیاسی قیاسی قیاسی قیاسی قیاسی

suggesting something by resemblance.

Example: "her robes were vaguely reminiscent of military dress"

Synonyms: similar to, comparable with, tending to make one think of, evocative of, suggestive of, redolent of

Antonyms: unaware, incognizant, unmindful, mindless

Intrude (verb) قیاسی قیاسی قیاسی قیاسی قیاسی

put oneself deliberately into a place or situation where one is unwelcome or uninvited.

Example: "he had no right to intrude into their lives"

Synonyms: encroach, impinge, trespass, infringe, obtrude, thrust oneself in, invade

Antonyms: withdraw, remove

Felicity (noun) قیاسی قیاسی قیاسی قیاسی قیاسی

intense happiness.

Example: "domestic felicity"

Synonyms: happiness, joy, joyfulness, joyousness, rapture, bliss, euphoria, delight

Antonyms: unhappiness

Kowtow (verb) قیاسی قیاسی قیاسی قیاسی قیاسی

act in an excessively subservient manner.

Example: "she didn't have to kowtow to a boss"

Synonyms: grovel, behave obsequiously, be obsequious, be servile, be sycophantic, fawn on

Antonyms: despise, disdain, scorn
