Trajectory (noun) مسافت کا پتہ

the path followed by a projectile flying or an object moving under the action of given forces.

Example: "the missile's trajectory was preset"

Synonyms: course, route, path, track, line, orbit, flight, flight path, ambit, direction, bearing

Antonyms: uncreativity

Reckoning (noun) حساب و شمار

the action or process of calculating or estimating something.

Example: "the sixth, or by another reckoning eleventh, Earl of Mar"

Synonyms: calculation, estimation, computation, working out, summation, counting, addition

Antonyms: calibrating, measuring, scaling

Emanate (verb) نکلنا

(of a feeling, quality, or sensation) issue or spread out from (a source).

Example: "warmth emanated from the fireplace"

Synonyms: emerge, flow, pour, proceed, issue, ensue, come out, come forth, spread out

Antonyms: terminate, culminate, end, evene

Precarious (adjective) □□□□□□ □□□□□□ □□□

not securely held or in position; dangerously likely to fall or collapse.

Example: "a precarious ladder"

Synonyms: uncertain, insecure, unreliable, unsure, unpredictable, undependable, risky

Antonyms: safe, secure

Acrimony (noun) □□ □□□□□□ □□□□□□□□ □□□□□□ □□□

bitterness or ill feeling.

Example: "the AGM dissolved into acrimony"

Synonyms: bitterness, rancour, resentment, ill feeling, ill will, bad blood, animosity, hostility

Antonyms: goodwill

Catastrophe (noun) □□□□□□ □□□□□□

an event causing great and usually sudden damage or suffering; a disaster.

Example: "an environmental catastrophe"

Synonyms: disaster, calamity, cataclysm, crisis, holocaust, ruin, ruination, tragedy, blow

Antonyms: salvation, godsend

Accumulation (noun) □□□□ □□□□□□ □□□□□□□□

the acquisition or gradual gathering of something.

Example: "the accumulation of wealth"

Synonyms: amassing, building up, build-up, collection, gathering, assembling, assembly

Antonyms: dissipation

Emaciation (noun) □□□□ □□ □□ □□ □□ □□□□ □□□□

the state of being abnormally thin or weak.

Example: "thin to the point of emaciation"

Synonyms: thinness, boniness, scrawniness, skinniness, scragginess, starvation, underfeeding

Antonyms: obesity

Shamble (verb) □□□□ □□ □□□□ □□□□ □□□□ □□□□ □□□□□□□□

(of a person) move with a slow, shuffling, awkward gait.

Example: "he shambled off down the corridor"

Synonyms: shuffle, lumber, totter, dodder, stumble, scuff/drag one's feet, hobble, limp, ungainly

Antonyms: run, sprint, bound, dapper

Perceive (verb) □□□□ □□□□□□ □□□□ □□□□

become aware or conscious of (something); come to realize or understand.

Example: "his mouth fell open as he perceived the truth"

Synonyms: discern, recognize, become cognizant of, become aware of, become conscious of, get/come to know

Antonyms: disbelieve, misinterpret, neglect
