engage in a close fight or struggle without weapons; wrestle.

Example: "passers-by grappled with the man after the knife attack"

Synonyms: wrestle, struggle, tussle, brawl, fight, scuffle, clash, combat, battle, close, engage

Antonyms: let go of, release

turn away (one's eyes or thoughts).

Example: "she averted her eyes while we made stilted conversation"

Synonyms: turn aside, turn away, turn to one side

Antonyms: aid, allow, assist, help

Disquiet (verb) ڈسکویٹ ڈسکویٹ ڈسکویٹ ڈسکویٹ

make (someone) worried or uneasy.

Example: "world leaders are surely disquieted by the prospect of a global economic meltdown"

Synonyms: perturb, agitate, upset, disturb, unnerve, unsettle, discompose, disconcert, ruffle

Antonyms: calm

Grim (adjective) غمگین، غمناک، غمناک

very serious or gloomy.

Example: "his grim expression"

Synonyms: stern, forbidding, uninviting, unapproachable, aloof, distant, formidable, strict

Antonyms: amiable, pleasant

Revolt (verb) بغاوت، بغاوت، بغاوت، بغاوت

take violent action against an established government or ruler; rebel.

Example: "the Iceni revolted and had to be suppressed"

Synonyms: rebel, rise up, rise, take to the streets, take up arms, riot, mutiny, take part in an uprising

Antonyms: attractive, pleasant

Repressive (adjective) دہشت گرد، دہشت گرد، دہشت گرد

(especially of a social or political system) inhibiting or restraining personal freedom.

Example: "a repressive regime"

Synonyms: oppressive, authoritarian, despotic, tyrannical, tyrannous, dictatorial, fascist, autocratic

Antonyms: democratic, liberal

the practice of persuading someone to do something by using force or threats.

Example: "our problem cannot be solved by any form of coercion but only by agreement"

Synonyms: force, compulsion, constraint, duress, oppression, enforcement, harassment, intimidation

Antonyms: persuasion

a state or feeling of great physical or mental distress or discomfort.

Example: "a man who had brought her nothing but misery"

Synonyms: unhappiness, distress, wretchedness, hardship, suffering, affliction, anguish, anxiety

Antonyms: contentment, pleasure

likely or liable to be influenced or harmed by a particular thing.

Example: "patients with liver disease may be susceptible to infection"

Synonyms: open to, receptive to, vulnerable to, defenceless against, an easy target for

Antonyms: immune, resistant

a difference or contrast between similar things or people.

Example: "I was completely unaware of class distinctions"

Synonyms: difference, contrast, dissimilarity, dissimilitude, divergence, variance, variation, division

Antonyms: similarity
