Tenuous (adjective) نازک و کمزور

very weak or slight.

Example: "the tenuous link between interest rates and investment"

Synonyms: slight, insubstantial, flimsy, negligible, weak, fragile, shaky, sketchy, doubtful

Antonyms: convincing, substantial, strong

Salient (adjective) نمایاں و اہم

most noticeable or important.

Example: "it succinctly covered all the salient points of the case"

Synonyms: important, main, principal, major, chief, primary, notable, noteworthy, outstanding

Antonyms: unimportant, inconspicuous

Grim (adjective) گھبراہٹ و غمناک

very serious or gloomy.

Example: "his grim expression"

Synonyms: stern, forbidding, uninviting, unapproachable, aloof, distant, formidable, strict
Antonyms: amiable, pleasant

Reluctance (noun) ██████████ ████████ ██████ ███

unwillingness or disinclination to do something.

Example: "she sensed his reluctance to continue"

Synonyms: unwillingness, disinclination, lack of enthusiasm, hesitation, hesitance, hesitancy, diffidence

Antonyms: willingness, eagerness

Pragmatic (adjective) ██████████ ██████████ ████████

dealing with things sensibly and realistically in a way that is based on practical rather than theoretical considerations

Synonyms: practical, matter-of-fact, realistic, sensible, down-to-earth, commonsensical

Antonyms: impractical, unrealistic, idealistic

Desirous (adjective) ██████████ ████████████████████

having or characterized by desire.

Example: "the Pope was desirous of peace in Europe"

Synonyms: eager for, desiring, wishing for, hoping for, anxious for, keen on/for, avid for

Antonyms: averse to

Surmise (verb) ██████████ ████████

suppose that something is true without having evidence to confirm it.

Example: "he surmised that something must be wrong"

Synonyms: guess, conjecture, suspect, deduce, infer, come to the conclusion, conclude

Antonyms: know

Proliferate (verb) بڑھنا بڑھنا بڑھنا بڑھنا

increase rapidly in number; multiply.

Example: "the science fiction magazines which proliferated in the 1920s"

Synonyms: increase rapidly, grow rapidly, multiply, become more numerous, mushroom

Antonyms: decrease, dwindle

Cognizant (adjective) جاننے والا جاننے والا جاننے والا

having knowledge or awareness.

Example: "statesmen must be cognizant of the political boundaries within which they work"

Synonyms: aware, conscious, apprised, abreast, sensible of/to, alive to, sensitive to

Antonyms: ignorant, senseless, thoughtless

Ludicrous (adjective) بے جا بے جا بے جا بے جا

so foolish, unreasonable, or out of place as to be amusing.

Example: "it's ludicrous that I have been fined"

Synonyms: absurd, ridiculous, farcical, laughable, risible, preposterous, foolish, idiotic

Antonyms: sensible

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
